WAS HELD ON SUNDAY, 12TH JULY, 2026

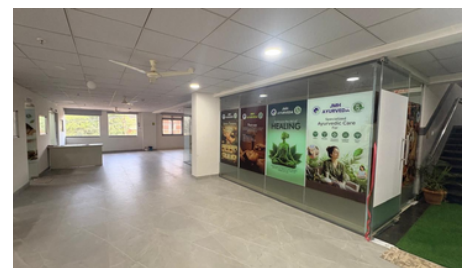

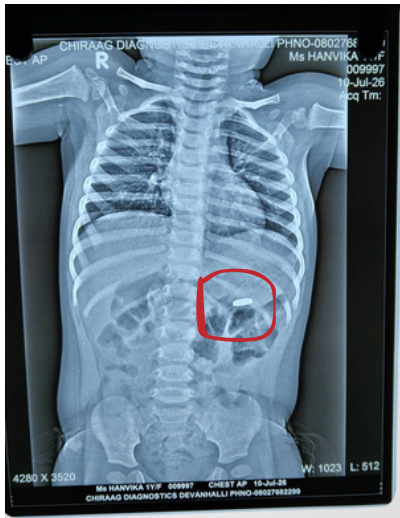

JAIN MISSION HOSPITAL SUCCESSFULLY REMOVES COIN BATTERY FROM ONE-YEAR-OLD CHILD ON JULY 10, 2026



DOCTORS AT JAIN MISSION HOSPITAL, CHIKKABALLAPUR, SUCCESSFULLY REMOVED A COIN BATTERY THAT HAD BECOME LODGED IN THE STOMACH OF A ONE-YEAR-OLD CHILD, **PREVENTING A POTENTIALLY LIFE-THREATENING MEDICAL EMERGENCY.**

A ONE YEAR OLD CHILD, FROM DEVANAHALLI, ACCIDENTALLY SWALLOWED A COIN BATTERY COMMONLY USED IN WATCHES AND OTHER SMALL ELECTRONIC DEVICES WHILE PLAYING AT HOME. REALIZING THE SERIOUSNESS OF THE SITUATION, HER PARENTS IMMEDIATELY RUSHED HER TO JAIN MISSION HOSPITAL FOR EMERGENCY TREATMENT.

FOLLOWING A DETAILED CLINICAL EXAMINATION AND DIAGNOSTIC INVESTIGATIONS, THE MEDICAL TEAM CONFIRMED THAT THE BATTERY WAS LODGED IN THE CHILD'S STOMACH. WITHIN A SHORT PERIOD, THE DOCTORS DECIDED TO PERFORM AN EMERGENCY ENDOSCOPIC PROCEDURE.

THE BATTERY WAS SUCCESSFULLY REMOVED UNDER SEDATION USING UPPER GASTROINTESTINAL (GI) ENDOSCOPY, WITHOUT ANY COMPLICATIONS. THE TIMELY INTERVENTION PREVENTED SERIOUS INJURY TO THE CHILD'S DIGESTIVE TRACT, AND THE CHILD RECOVERED WELL AFTER THE PROCEDURE.

THE SUCCESSFUL TREATMENT REFLECTS THE EXPERTISE AND PROMPT RESPONSE OF THE MEDICAL TEAM AT JAIN MISSION HOSPITAL IN MANAGING PEDIATRIC EMERGENCIES.

THE PROCEDURE WAS SUCCESSFULLY PERFORMED BY DR. KARTHIK, DR. VIJAY N., AND THE OPERATION THEATRE (OT) TEAM, WHOSE SKILL AND TEAMWORK ENSURED A SUCCESSFUL OUTCOME.

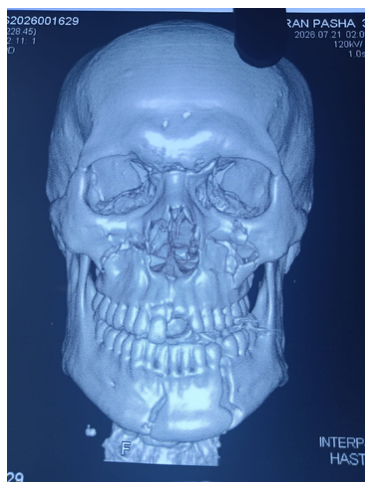
FIRST CRANIOTOMY SURGERY AT JAIN MISSION HOSPITAL ON 15TH JULY, 2026



JAIN MISSION HOSPITAL ACHIEVED A SIGNIFICANT MILESTONE BY SUCCESSFULLY PERFORMING ITS FIRST CRANIOTOMY SURGERY, MARKING A MAJOR ADVANCEMENT IN ITS NEUROSURGICAL CAPABILITIES. THIS ACCOMPLISHMENT REFLECTS THE HOSPITAL'S COMMITMENT TO DELIVERING ADVANCED, HIGH-QUALITY SURGICAL CARE AND WAS MADE POSSIBLE THROUGH THE DEDICATED EFFORTS OF THE NEUROSURGERY, ANAESTHESIA, NURSING, AND OPERATION THEATRE TEAMS.

JAIN MISSION HOSPITAL SUCCESSFULLY MANAGED A HIGHLY COMPLEX PANFACIAL RECONSTRUCTION SURGERY ON 27TH JULY, 2026



JAIN MISSION HOSPITAL SUCCESSFULLY MANAGED A COMPLEX PANFACIAL RECONSTRUCTION CASE,

DEMONSTRATING ITS GROWING EXPERTISE IN ADVANCED TRAUMA AND MAXILLOFACIAL CARE.

THE PATIENT PRESENTED WITH MULTIPLE FACIAL FRACTURES INVOLVING THE MAXILLA, ZYGOMA, MANDIBLE, NASAL BONE, ORBIT AND SPHENOID, ALONG WITH A WRIST FRACTURE. DUE TO THE DIFFICULT AIRWAY, SUBMENTAL INTUBATION WAS SAFELY PERFORMED.

THE FACIAL SKELETON WAS METICULOUSLY RECONSTRUCTED USING SIX TITANIUM PLATES AND 37 SCREWS, RESTORING FACIAL ALIGNMENT AND STABILITY. THE WRIST FRACTURE WAS TREATED WITH CLOSED REDUCTION AND K-WIRE FIXATION.

THE SUCCESSFUL OUTCOME WAS ACHIEVED THROUGH THE COORDINATED EFFORTS OF THE ORTHOPAEDIC TEAM AND DEDICATED OPERATION THEATRE STAFF.

THIS LANDMARK CASE REFLECTS JAIN MISSION HOSPITAL'S COMMITMENT TO ADVANCED SURGICAL CARE, MULTIDISCIPLINARY TEAMWORK AND CLINICAL EXCELLENCE.
